The Senior Courts of Belize, through the Office of the Chief Justice and the National Alternative Dispute Resolution Committee (NADRC), invite suitably qualified persons to apply for appointment as Court-Connected Criminal and/or Civil Mediators.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must:

- Possess certification in criminal and/or civil mediation, with the level of training attained
- Demonstrate knowledge and competence in mediation techniques, processes, and practices
- Be a person of good character

Required Documents

Applicants are required to submit:

1. Proof of certification in criminal or civil mediation.
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a qualified mediator in Belize.
3. A valid police record of good character.
4. Curriculum vitae including contact information, geographic location, languages spoken, employment status, areas of expertise, and proof of membership with the Alternative Dispute Resolution Association of Belize (ADRAB) or other relevant professional body.
